Article 3, paragraph (1) of the Directive No. 3/2017 is supplemented as follows.

Article 3

(1) The individual study plan contains the subject which the PhD student shall take exams in during the course of study. The selection of these subjects is proposed by the instructor, who submits the material to the specialised council for approval. The subjects are chosen from the offer of specialised subjects, a list of which is provided in the accreditation materials for each PhD study program. The number of prescribed subjects is determined by the accreditation material for the given study program. Part of the study obligations in the doctoral study programme is the completion of part of the study at a foreign institution in the total length of at least one month. After approval of the individual study plan by the specialised council and faculty dean, the material including the prescribed exams becomes binding for the student.
