### Article 1

(1) Article 5 is revoked and it is supplemented as follows:

The minimum requirement for defence of the dissertation thesis is the co-authorship of the student on 2 peer-reviewed publications published or accepted for publication in a journal with an impact factor listed in the Web of Science Core Collection database with the designation "article", with at least one of the publications being the first-authored. Both of these publications must clearly demonstrate the student's contribution, and they must contain original results included in the dissertation thesis. The second publication can be replaced by a granted patent or a validated technology. The condition for applying a validated technology is its testing in production supported by a protocol and documentation of the technical results.

### Article 2 Final Provisions

- (1) Other provisions of the Directive No. 3/2017, including Amendments No. 1, No. 2, and No. 3, shall remain unchanged.
- (2) This Amendment No. 4 shall come into validity on the day of signature.
- (3) This Amendment No. 4 shall become effective on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025.
