### **Preamble**

- 1) This directive, in accordance with Section 70, paragraph 4 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments and Supplements to Some Other Acts, as amended and Article 35 of the Statute of the University of Pardubice, defines the status of “emeritus professor” at the Faculty of Chemical Technology (hereinafter referred to as "FChT") of the University of Pardubice (hereinafter referred to as "UPCE"). Furthermore, this document sets the conditions for appointment as an “emeritus professor“, as well as the rights and obligations of an “emeritus professor” at the FChT.

### **Article 1**

#### **Emeritus Professor**

- 1) A professor emeritus of the FChT is an honorary title.
- 2) Appointment as a professor emeritus does not create any employment or property rights.
- 3) A duly appointed professor who is over 65 years of age and was previously employed at the FChT as a professor for at least 10 years may become a professor emeritus.
- 4) A professor emeritus has the right to participate in research and other creative activities and, for this purpose, may use the facilities and information technologies of the FChT and the UPCE.
- 5) A professor emeritus may publish under the faculty's affiliation and also act as a mentor.
- 6) A professor emeritus is not an academic employee, must adhere to all applicable laws of the Czech Republic, and follow the internal documents of the FChT and the UPCE.
- 7) A professor emeritus upholds the good name of the FChT and the UPCE.

### **Article 2**

#### **Appointment as an Emeritus Professor**

- 1) The appointment as an “emeritus professor” is initiated based on a proposal from the Dean of the FChT submitted to the Scientific Board of the FChT.

- 2) After deliberation by the the Scientific Board of the FChT, the Dean forwards the proposal to the Rector of the UPCE in accordance with Article 35, Section 3 of the Statute of the University of Pardubice.

### **Article 3**

#### **Appointment as an Emeritus Professor**

- 3) A professor emeritus is appointed based on the decision of the Rector of the UPCE in accordance with Article 35, Section 3 of the Statute of the University of Pardubice.

#### **Final provisions**

- 1) This directive shall come into effect on the date of its signature.
- 2) This directive shall become effective on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2024.
