Article 1

Subject of regulation

This Dean's Regulation (hereinafter the "regulation") stipulates the rules for registering university qualification theses (hereinafter "UQT") at the Faculty of Chemical Technology of University of Pardubice (hereinafter the "faculty") in relation to the annually published faculty Directive 1) Schedule of state final exams for bachelor study programs in the respective academic year and 2) Schedule of state final exams for follow-up masters study programs in the respective academic year.

Article 2

Qualification requirements for the person conducting UQT

1. The bachelor's thesis within the framework of bachelor study programs organised by the faculty may be conducted only by an academic employee of the faculty with minimally a master's degree (Ing., Mgr.).
2. The master's thesis within the framework of follow-up masters study programs organised by the faculty may be conducted only by an academic employee of the faculty with minimally a doctorate degree or adequate level of education (PhD., Dr., CSc.).
3. In connection to the Study and Examination Regulations of University of Pardubice (Art. 12), the instructor in the PhD study program organised by the faculty may only be a professor, associate professor, or emeritus professor, or a leading expert in the given field upon approval by the scientific council of the faculty.

Article 3

Number of UQT conducted by one person

1. One person may conduct maximally 8 bachelor's and master's theses in one academic year, of which maximally 5 can be master's theses.
2. One person may simultaneously be the instructor for maximally 5 PhD study program students (organised by the faculty) in the form of full-time study.

Article 4

Final provisions

1. This measure comes into effect on the date of signing.
